

EPA Certified Renovator Training

JUNE 22, 2010

Effective April 22, 2010:

According to the EPA's new RRP Lead Paint Rule, nearly all renovations done to pre-1978 housing must be performed by an EPA Certified Renovator.

Plan to Attend! For those who need to be certified, CAA has engaged *ap Inspections and Environmental Services*, an EPA-accredited national training provider, to offer the required new EPA Certified Renovator initial full-day course for the benefit of CAA members and their affiliated contractors and subcontractors.

This full-day EPA accredited course will lead to the EPA Certified Renovator discipline certification, which will be valid for five years from the date of successful completion of the course.

With the compliance deadline already passed for this new Federal regulation, now is the time to take action - register today!

Who must be certified?

Any workers removing or modifying painted surfaces in pre-1978 housing and pre-1978 child-occupied facilities. This includes renovators, remodelers, painters, contractors and property maintenance personnel.

What happens if I don't comply?

Failure to comply with the RRP, including the preparation and retention of properly executed documents, can result in substantial fines of up to \$32,500 per required item, per day, for each business day for three (3) years from the date of the original violation
